



ITI French Network Grants Policy

General

The ITI French Network offers various grants throughout its membership year. All grants are awarded on a first come, first served basis, depending on the total funds set aside per membership year by the French Network Committee.

All grant awards are entirely at the Committee's discretion. Grant recipients will be asked to write a short piece for *Au Courant*, the French Network's newsletter, talking about their experience and how the grant made a difference to their professional practice.

MITI upgrade grants

All ITI members of the French Network are eligible for an MITI upgrade grant provided they:

- have been a member of the ITI French Network for **at least two years**
- upgrade to **MITI with French** as their source language or target language
- apply for the grant **within six months** of their MITI application (members can contact the Treasurer first to check they meet the grant criteria before applying)

The standard grant awarded is **£100** per recipient and is payable on presentation of the upgrade fee receipt from ITI head office. (See the ITI website for the details about upgrading to [MITI translator](#) and [MITI interpreter](#).)

Grants for CPD

All ITI members of the French Network may apply for a grant to attend a training event – whether organised by the French Network, ITI or any other provider – as long as:

- the grant relates to an event taking place in the applicant's **current membership year**
- the applicant has been a member of the ITI French Network for **at least two years** at the time of the event

The grant can be used for both course and transport/accommodation costs, and the maximum amount awarded per person per annum is **£100**. There is a lifetime cap of **£500** per person.

Grant for organising training events

The French Network committee is sometimes able to offer grants to members willing to organise an event, to help with expenses. Any interested member should contact the Treasurer with a rough idea of the costs involved. The Committee will then review the proposal and advise of its potential contribution.

Mentoring scheme grants

The ITI French Network has set up subsidised translation and business [mentoring schemes](#). The total cost of each scheme is £160, with the mentee and the Network both contributing £80.
